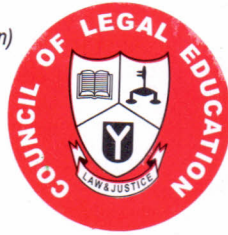

A. INTRODUCTION

The Nigerian Civil Aviation Authority (NCAA), a Parastatal under the Federal Ministry of Transport (FMT), in pursuance of its statutory oversight functions and in compliance with Public Procurement Act, 2007, hereby invites interested, competent and reputable companies to tender for projects under its 2016 internally generated revenue (IGR) budget, as follows:

- viii. Evidence of registration on the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) National Data base of Contractors, Consultants and service providers.
- ix. As sworn affidavit affirming that none of the Directors of the company has been convicted in any country for criminal offences, including fraud and financial impropriety.
- x. Evidence of registration with PENCOM and up to date remittance of employee Pension Fund Contributions.
- xi. Company profile which should include names, qualifications and experience of key personnel with copies of credentials.
- xii. Evidence of registration with the Financial Reporting Council of Nigeria.
- xiii. Evidence of registration with the Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) and up to date remittance.
- xiv. Evidence of compliance with industrial Training Fund (ITF) Act, 2005.
