

From the analysis, Gridline Ltd had fifteen (15) of the major items with rates fair and reasonable compared to BPP rates.

This was followed closely by Edil Nig. Ltd with twelve (12), Patibon Services, Eksato Engineering, Seda Nig. Ltd and Yar Barkat with ten (10) each, while Arid Builders and Imanil Haq Ltd had Nine (9) and Seven (7) respectively.

Arid Builders had the lowest quotation of N72,689,897.12, but was found not responsive as some rates were too low.

REQUEST FOR "NO OBJECTION" TO ENGAGE IN PROCUREMENT BY MEANS OF RESTRICTED TENDERING.

This is to refer to your letter with Ref. No: TRCN/DP/PQE/16/VOL.1/65 dated 9th November, 2016 but received at the Bureau on 15th November, 2016 and another letter Ref: No. TRCN/DP/PQE/16/VOL.1/69 dated 16th November, 2016 forwarding the technical and financial bids of the invited firms for the development of the test items for the Professional Qualifying Examination (PQE) for Teachers.

- 2. It should be recalled that the Bureau had earlier reviewed the Teachers Registration Council of Nigeria (TRCN) request vide their unreferenced letter dated 17th August, 2016 and observed that the Council did not state in their submission the method used earlier for conducting of the Qualifying Examinations and also did not submit any company profile or suggest any firm reputable enough to conduct the Qualifying Examination for the Bureau's review. Therefore, the Bureau granted the Council "No Objection" on the condition that the reputable firm that satisfy the eligibility requirements in line with Section 16 (6) of the Public Procurement Act, 2007 and have registered in the ongoing registration and categorization of contractors, suppliers and services providers at the Bureau's website by providing copy of the Interim Registration Report (IRR) as evidence of registration is recommended for award after the financial evaluation.
- Subsequently, the Teachers Registration Council of Nigeria (TRCN) in their current letter under reference, forwarded the profile of the invited bidders and the evaluation reports and requested the Bureau to grant Due Process "No Objection" for the engagement of a firm for the development of the test items for the Professional Qualifying Examination (PQE) for Teachers. In the current letter under reference, the TRCN stated as follows:
 - a. Please the above subject matter Ref. No. and your **BPP/S.1/SP/16/VOL.1/286** dated **August 26, 2016** refers.
 - i. The Council did not state the method used earlier for the conducting of the Professional Qualifying Examinations and also did not submit any

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
- company profile or suggest any firm reputable enough to conduct the Qualifying Examination for the Bureau's review.
- ii. Due Process "No Objection" can be granted to Teachers Registration Council of Nigeria to adopt Restricted Procurement Method for the development of the Test Items for the Professional Qualifying Examination (PQE) for teachers in Nigeria due to its sensitive and confidential nature on the condition that the reputable firm that satisfy the eligibility requirements in line with section 16(6) of the Public Procurement Act, 2007 and SGF circular No.: SGF/SO/S.52/II dated 11th December, 2014 stating that only firms that have registered on the Bureau's database should be awarded Federal Government contracts from year 2015.
- iii. The Teachers Registration Council of Nigeria (TRCN) should forward the invited Company profiles, tender submissions and financial evaluation to the Bureau for review before contract award.
- b. In view of the foregoing, the Council wishes to state that:
- i. The Council conducted the teachers Professional Qualifying Examinations (PQE) in year 2008 but encountered some challenges in the areas of specialization and categorization of teachers. This led to the development and production of the TRCN Professional Qualifying Examination (PQE) National Benchmarks which would be used now for the PQE Test Development and creation of databank of about 1,840 test items.
- ii. Council sent out Invitation to Tender to four Companies namely:
 - 1. Concept College London Limited,
 - 2. Nana &Trad Mega Logistics Limited,
 - 3. Mekkembuk Consultants Limited, and
 - 4. Academia Consulting.
- iii. The companies' profiles were evaluated and three of them were cleared and their financial bids were subsequently evaluated. The review are as follows:

1. Preamble

The Teachers Registration Council of Nigeria (TRCN), Abuja signed a contract with Nana & Trad Mega Logistics Nig. Ltd Abuja (Consultant) to develop 1,840 test items for Professional Qualifying Examination in Nigeria. The Consultant was given eight weeks (up to February 06, 2017) to complete the assignment. This interim report is to formally inform TRCN that the work has commenced and all necessary steps have been taken to ensure that the test items are delivered on time as schedule.

It is pleasing to note that the Registrar/Chief Executive personally with his Management team has inaugurated the Core Group (tagged the Test Development Team) that will completely steer and manage the test development. The Test Development Team members are not the experts to construct the tests. Rather, they have the responsibility to superintend the entire process, identifying the experts to construct the tests, monitoring and advising till the end of the test development processes and finally to validate the test items. This is a most thorough and guaranteed framework that ensures that TRCN will have test items that are world-class. Team comprises of leaders, professors and experts in the faculties and institutes of education in Nigerian universities and colleges of Education. They are selected from various institutions across the country. The Chair of the Team is Professor Grace Offorma of the University of Nigeria Nsukka, a renowned curriculum expert and World Vice President of the Curriculum Organisation while the co-chairman is Professor Gbenga Adewale of the University of Ibadan, a seasoned Professor of Measurement and Evaluation.

After the inauguration, both the consultants and test development team have commenced work in the various designated universities and colleges of education. Further briefs about the on-going exercise are given below.
