(1) INTRODUCTION

The Lagos University Teaching Hospital, Idi- Araba intends to upgrade and outsource the filling station facilities within the Hospital premises. (2) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- (b) Evidence of Company Income's Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2016, 2017 and 2018) valid till 31st December, 2018;

- Disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Lagos State University Teaching Hospital or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;
- That the company is not bankrupt, in receivership or under liquidation or involved in any litigation which can potentially affect the company's ability to effectively discharge their responsibility if engaged;
 - (i) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016 and 2017);
 - (j) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;

- (k) Company Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications
- (I) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, lob Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;
