(1.0) INTRODUCTION

- (2.4) All tickets are to be provided on fixed sum commission per ticket.

(3.0) PRE-QULIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

NNPC in compliance with the provision of Public Procurement Act 2007 request interested companies to submit the details listed below in their prequalification bid documents:

- (3.1) Full details of company profile with certificate of incorporation in Nigeria, certified true copies of Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company and CAC form 2 (particulars of shareholders) and 7 (Particulars of Directors)
- (3.2) Company Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2017, 2018 & 2019.)
- (3.3) Proof of Company's financial capabilities, including Audited accounts for the last three- (3) years 2017.2018 & 2019 (the audited accounts must bear the stamp and seal of the Audit Firm), along with (Annual Turnover of N400m and Net worth of N200M)
- (3.4) Evidence of IATA certification.
- (3.5) Current and in-place organizational structure with detailed experience and skills of key management personnel with names. Provide evidence (personnel list and position organizational chart).
- (3.6) Evidence of similar jobs executed by the Company in the last Ten (10) years. Please attach reference letters.
- (3.7) Submission of Bank reference(s) from your bank(s).
- (3.8) Evidence of compliance with the provisions of Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Amendment Act 2011.
- (3.9) Evidence of compliance with PENCOM Reform Act 2004 by inclusion of valid Pension Clearance Certificate
- (3.10) Evidence of compliance with the Nigerian Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Act by inclusion of copy of Compliance Certificate
- (3.11) Evidence of registration on the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPPs) National Data Base of Federal Contractors. Consultants and Service Providers (NDCCSPs) by inclusion of interim Registration Report (IRR) (for Nigerian companies)
- (3.12) A prospective bidder shall make provision of sworn affidavit to support actions as follows:
- (a) To allow NNPC verify all claims made in your submission.
- (b) To allow NNPC verify that your organization is not in receivership, nor the subject of any form of insolvency of bankruptcy proceedings or the subject of any form of winding up petition or proceedings.

- (c) To confirm that the Bidder is not a replacement for a hitherto tax defaulting company.
- (d) To confirm whether or not any of the members of relevant committees of NNPC or Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) is former or present Director, shareholder, or has any pecuniary interest in your Company.
- (e) A written statement confirming that your company does not have any Director who has been convicted in any country for a criminal offence relating to fraud or any financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation of falsification of facts relating to any matter.
- (3.13) Membership of relevant association (e.g. NANTA).
- (3.14) Relevant Department of Petroleum Resources (DPR) permit.
- (3.15) Company's CASHES and QA/QC policy and details of safety records for accidents, incidents, injuries and damages for the past three (3) years.
- (3.16) Any additional information that will enhance your qualification.
