(1.0) Introduction

- To implement access control policy of the corporation and ensure compliance with Corporation Security Policy/Procedure at NNPC Towers/Executive Residences,
 - (B) Security services shall be provided twenty-four (24) hours daily inclusive of Saturday, Sunday and Public holidays.
 - (C) Security incidences at various facilities/Executive Residences shall immediately be reported by the Service provider(s) to NNPC Security Department.
 - (D) Proposed Duration: 2 years plus an option for one year renewal

- (3.12) Nigerian Content plan that demonstrates full utilization of Nigerian labor and services with detailed description of role, work scope and man-hours in order to achieve minimum target as set out in the requirement of the NOFICD Act 2010
- (3.13) Current and in-place organizational structure with detailed experience and skills of key management personnel with names. Provide evidence (personnel list and position organizational chart).
- (3.14) Evidence of operating a security training Academy

- (3.16) List of verifiable similar service detailing companies that the service is being rendered to. Company full contact address (Not P.O. Box), Functional phone numbers and e-mail address,
