- (3) Evidence of financial capability:
- (i) Bank reference letter
- (ii) Audited financial statements for 2015, 2016, and 2017 (Showing minimum overage annual turnover of N50million during the three year period)
- (4) Tax Clearance Certificate for 2015, 2016, and 2017
- (5) Certificate of registration and valid/current membership with the National Insurance Commission (NICOM)
- (6) Certificate of registration and valid/current membership with the Nigerian Council of Registered insurance Brokers (NICRIB)
- (7) Evidence of experience in taking out and administering group life assurance policies for reputable organizations (especially INGOs)
- (8) Evidence of successful settlement of at least five claims (of minimum value of N15 million each) on life assurance policies within the last three years, with clear indication of how long it took to settle each claim.
- (9) Recommendation letter from a past or present client
