(i) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CAC 1.1 or CAC2 and CAC7;

(ii) Evidence of Company Income's Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years valid till 31st December, 2022;

(iii) Evidence of Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 15 and above);

(iv) Evidence of Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 5 and above or the bidder's annual turnover is N50m and above);

(v) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022;

(vi) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/12/2022 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.

(vii) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Federal School of Medical Laboratory Technology (Science), Jos or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.

(viii) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2019, 2020, 2021).

(ix) Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed.

(x) Company's Profile with Curriculum Vitae of key staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications.

(xi) Verifiable documentary' evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and photographs of the projects.

(xii) Works: List of Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease.

(xiii) For Supply of Equipment: Letter of Authorization from the Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs)

(xv) For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension Compliance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Compliance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV partner);

(xvi) All documents for submission MUST be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper MUST bear the

Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorized officer of the company/firm.

(4.0) COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

(5.0) SUBMISSION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

Prospective bidders are to submit bid for each of the Lot desired, two (2) hard copies each of the Technical and Financial bids with soft copy of financial bid only in MS Excel format, packaged separately in sealed envelopes and clearly marked as "Technical Bid" or "Financial Bid". Thereafter, put the two sealed envelopes together in a bigger sealed envelope addressed to THE PROVOST/CEO, FEDERAL SCHOOL OF MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY (SCIENCE), JOS, PLATEAU STATE, and clearly marked with THE NAME OF THE PROJECT AND THE LOT NUMBER. (a) Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorised by the Bidders.

- (b) Bids submitted after the deadline for submission would be returned un-opened.
- (c) Bidders should not bid for more than Two (2) Lots.
- (d) All costs will be borne by the bidders.

(e) Presence of bidders/representatives and members of the public shall not be required during the bid opening ceremony in Compliance with COVID-19 Guidelines. The Bids Opening will be covered by video recording (invitation link will be sent to bidders to

join the bid opening online) with the physical presence of two (2) representatives of private sector professional bodies and Civil Society Organisation in the areas of Anti-Corruption/Transparency;
