**FOI REQUEST FOR REVISED PROJECT SCHEDULE FOR BID NO NGP-D2;  
SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF HVDS IN KARU, LAGOS AND IBADAN**

On behalf of the Nigerian Contract Monitoring Coalition and in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2011, I write to request for the revised project implementation schedule for *Bid No. NGP-D2 for the supply of 300 units of 11 KV, 500A On-Load Sectionalizers for installation at the High Voltage Distribution System (HVDS) networks at Karu in Abuja; at the Lagos University Teaching Hospital (LUTH) Ogba and Agege in Lagos; as well as at Challenge in Ibadan, Oyo State.*

This request is made in view of the fact that the project has faced delays which have rendered the original schedule inapplicable for monitoring project implementation.
