A Bill for an Act to authorise the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the Federation total Revenue the sum of =N=4,877,209,156,933 (Four Trillion, Eight Hundred and Seventy Seven Billion, Two Hundred and Nine Million, One Hundred and Fifty-Six Thousand, Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three Naira) only, of which, =N=372,593,095,601 (Three Hundred and Seven-Two Billion, Five Hundred and Ninety-Three Million, Ninety-Five Thousand, Six Hundred and One Naira) Only is for Statutory Transfers, =N=559,580,000,000 (Five Hundred and Fifty-Nine Billion, Five Hundred and Eighty Million Naira) Only is for Debt Service, =N=2,425,049,954,640 (Two Trillion, Four Hundred and Twenty Five Billion, Forty Nine Million, Nine Hundred and Fifty Four Thousand, Six Hundred and Forty Naira) Only, is for Recurrent (Non-Debt) Expenditure while the balance of =N=1,519,986,106,691 (One Trillion, Five Hundred and Nineteen Billion, Nine Hundred and Eighty Six Million, One Hundred and Six Thousand, Six Hundred and Ninety One Naira) Only, is for contribution to the Development Fund for Capital Expenditure for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2012.

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: -

(i) The Accountant-General of the Federation shall, when authorised to do so by Warrants signed by the Minister charged with responsibility for finance, pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation during the year ending on the 31st day of December 2012, the sums specified by the warrants, not exceeding in the aggregate =N=4,877,209,156,933 (Four Trillion, Eight Hundred and Seventy Seven Billion, Two Hundred and Nine Million, One Hundred and Fifty-Six Thousand, Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three Naira) only.

Issue and appropriation of =N=4,877,209,156,933 from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for 2012

(ii) The amount mentioned in subsection (i) of this section is hereby appropriated to the heads of expenditure as specified in the Schedule to this Act.

(iii) No part of the amount aforesaid shall be released from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation after the end of the year mentioned in subsection (i) of this section.
