- (d) Evidence of registration with the SDGs Office in Ekiti State;

- (e) Evidence of Ekiti State Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) financial years;
- (f) Evidence of payment of Development Levy for the last three (3) financial years;
- (g) Evidence of registration of Business Premises in Ekiti state;
- (h) Evidence of registration with Ekiti State Bureau of Public Procurement;
- (i) Reference letter from a reputable Bank;

(j) Evidence of previous relevant/similar experience in terms of project value, volume, complexity and management in the last five (5) years. Provision of Certificate (s) of completion is an added advantage;

(I) Evidence of Value Added Tax (VAT) registration.

(2) **COMMERCIAL BID:** This will involve the presentation of priced

bills to confirm competitiveness.
