- (viii) Evidence of experience in at least five (5) jobs of similar nature and complexity executed within the last five years with verifiable letters of contract awards and certificates of job completion.
- (ix) Verifiable evidence of experience and relevant Qualifications of key personnel
- (x) Evidence of compliance with the industrial Training fund Amendment Act 2011 inclusion of compliance Certificate from the Industrials Training Fund (ITF).
- (xi) Evidence of compliance with National Social Insurance Trust Fund by inclusion of Compliance Certificate from The National Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF).
