(2) TENDER/EXPRESSION OF INTEREST REQUIREMENTS:

Interested and competent Contractors/Consultants wishing to carry out any of the projects are required to submit the following documents which will be subjected to verification and due diligence by the institution.

(A) MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- (i) Evidence of company Registration with Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC);
- (ii) Evidence of current Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016 and 2017).with annual turnover of N155million for works and N5million for goods;
- (iii) Evidence of current Certificate of Compliance with the National Pension Commission (PENCOM) **valid till 31 December, 2018;**
- (iv) Evidence of current Compliance Certificate by the Industrial Trust Fund (ITF) **valid till 31 December, 2018;**
- (v) Evidence Current Compliance Certificate with National Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) **valid till 31 December, 2018;**
- (vi) Evidence of Duly Signed and Stamped Unabridged Company Audited Account for the last Three (3) years (2015, 2016 and 2017);
- (vii) Evidence of valid Interim Registration Report (IRR) issued by the Bureau of Public Procurement;
- (viii) Current Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not:
 - (a) The company is not in receivership, insolvent, and/or bankrupt.
 - (b) The company does not have any Director who has ever been convicted in any court for criminal offence in relation to fraud or financial impropriety.
 - (c) That no officer(s) of Federal Medical Centre, Asaba, Delta State or the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP), is a former and present Directors, Shareholders of your company or have a pecuniary interest in the project.
 - (d) That the company has complied with the local content policy of the Federal Government in its employment of Staff and materials for work to at least 40%. And confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particular.

(3) EVALUATION REQUIREMENTS:

(i) List of at least (3) similar, verifiable and successfully executed projects by the Company in the past (5) years with the letters of award, Completion certificate, Valuation Certificate and Photographs.

(ii) Company Profile with Curriculum Vitae of key Staff of the Company to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic /Professional qualifications (in case of construction: COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc).

(iii) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project including Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank including willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed.

(iv) List of Plant/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease.

(v) For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided.

(4) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

(i) Please note that Post Qualification would be carried out to re-confirm the claim of the bidder and how genuinely Original are the document presented for bidding in line with provision of Section 107 of the Procurement Regulations.

(ii) Non-compliance to the instructions and late submission will lead to disqualification of the bidder from the bidding process.

Thereafter, put the two sealed envelopes together in a bigger sealed envelope marked the appropriate Project title and the relevant lot number, Name of company, address and valid contact phone number behind.
