INVITATION TO TENDER (TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL) FOR 2018 TETFUND NORMAL INTERVENTION FOR YEARS 2014, 2015 AND 2016 MERGED AND 2018 CAPITAL APPROPRIATION FEDERAL COLLEGE OF EDUCATION (TECHNICAL)

(1.0) INTRODUCTION:

The Federal College of Education (Technical) Gusau hereby invites applications from suitable and interested contractors with relevant experience and good track record for pre-qualification as prerequisite for tender in respect of 2014, 2015 and 2016 Merged TETFund Normal Intervention and 2018 Capital appropriation projects.

(2.0) SCOPE OF WORK

(2.1) 2018 CAPITAL APPROPRIATION PROJECTS

Lot 1: Procurement of Transformer

Lot 2: Completion of School of Education (ongoing)

Lot 3: Perimeter fencing (ongoing)

Lot 4: Purchase of Motor vehicle

(2.2) TETFUND PROJECTS

Lot 1: Construction of Office Complex for School of Adult and Non formal Education (Construction & furnishing).

Lot 2: Construction of Academic Staff Offices (Construction & furnishing).

Lot 3: Construction of Business Education Complex (Construction & furnishing).

Lot 4: Renovation of School of Science Complex.

Lot 5: Renovation of Poultry House, Fish Pond and relocation of Feed Mill.

Lot 6: Renovation of Gymnasium for PHE Department.

Lot 7: Provision of furniture, play ground with equipment for ECCDE

(3.0) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

(i) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including CAC2 and CAC7.

(ii) Evidence of registration on the National database of Federal contractors, consultants and service providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 1/1/2019 or valid certificate issued by BPP.

(iii) Evidence of Company income Tax Clearance Certificate for three (3) years (2015 -2017) valid till 31st Dec. 2018.

(iv) Audited Accounts for three (3) years (2015 – 2017).

(v) Comprehensive Company profile with the curriculum vitae of key staff to be deployed for the project including copies of their Academic professional qualification (in case of construction: COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc).

(vi) Evidence of financial capacity to execute the projects by submission of reference letter from a reputable commercial Bank indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed.

(vii) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) compliance certificate valid till 31st December, 2018.

(viii) Evidence of current pension compliance certificate valid till 31st December 2018.

(ix) Evidence of current Nigerian Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) compliance certificate valid till 31st December, 2018.

(x) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including letters of Awards, valuation certificates and photograph of the projects.

(xi) List of Plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease (where applicable):

(xii) Only companies included in the National Automobile Design and Development Council's approved list of local manufacturers of vehicles or their authorized representatives should bid for Lot 4;

(xiii) For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (all the eligibility requirements are compulsory for each JV partner).

(xiv) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/ Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorized officer of the firm.

(4.0) COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

Tender documents are obtainable from the office of the Head, Procurement, FCET Gusau upon the payment of a non-refundable tender processing fee of N10,000.00 (Ten Thousand naira) only per Lot paid to Federal College of Education (Technical) Gusau's TSA Account.

(5.0) SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

Prospective bidders are to submit pre-qualification documents for each of the Lot desired; two (2) hard copies each of the technical bids packaged in sealed envelopes and clearly marked as "Technical and Financial Bid". The two sealed envelopes should be put in a bigger envelope, addressed to the Head of Procurement, FCET Gusau, and clearly marked with (the name of the project and the Lot number). Furthermore, the reverse of each sealed envelope should have the name and address of the bidder; and drop in the designated Tender Box at the office of Head of Procurement FCET Gusau **not later than 10:00a.m. on Tuesday, 13 November, 2018.**

(6.0) OPENING OF PRE-QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS

The technical bids will be opened immediately after the deadline for submission at **10.00a.m. on Tuesday, 13 November, 2018** in the Council Chamber FCET Gusau in the presence of bidders or their representatives as well as Civil Society organization while the financial bids will be kept unopened. Please ensure that you sign the Bid submission Register in the office of Head of Procurement, as the College will not be held liable for misplaced or wrongly submitted bids. Only firms whose technical bids fulfill the minimum requirements would be contacted at a later date for financial bid opening exercise.

(i) The College reserves the right to authenticate all claims made by any contractor in its submission.

- (ii) Failure to provide any information required may lead to instant disqualification.
