(I) INTRODUCTION

The National Tuberculosis and Leprosy Control Programme (NTBLCP) is a division in the Department of Public Health, Federal Ministry of Health (FMOH) and is saddled with the responsibility of controlling Tuberculosis In Nigeria. The NTBLCP received a Global Fund grant for Tuberculosis for the year 2021 to 2023 as a Principal Recipient. The role in the grant is to coordinate all public sector Global Fund implementation and provide national guidance.

(II) SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SUPPLIES

NTBLCP is soliciting for interested and reputable Services providers, Contractors, Suppliers, Consultants and Organizations with relevant experience in the following Services during the grant implementation period:

(III) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- (i) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CAC1.1 or CAC2 and CAC7. Business Name is acceptable for Category B;
- (ii) Evidence of Company's Income Tax Clearance Certificate (or Personal Income Tax Clearance Certificates of all the Partners in case of Business Name) for the last three (3) years valid till 31st December, 2021;
- (iii) Evidence of current Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December 2021 (where applicable);
- (iv) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021 (where applicable);
- (v) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December 2021;
- (vi) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/12/2021 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.;
- (vii) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the National Tuberculosis Leprosy and Burull-Ulcer Control Programme or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest In the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;
- (viii) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years 2018, 2019, 2020;
- (ix) Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- (x) Company's Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications;

- (xi) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects.
- (xii) Letter of Authorization from Original Equipment Manufacturers for LOTS No 2 and 4;
- (xiii) Letter of Accreditation or Affiliation with Microsoft for LOT 2d;
- (xiv) Lot 5: Evidence of Firm's current registration with relevant regulatory professional body(ies);
- (xv) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

(IV) COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS (CATEGORY A)

Interested firms in Category B will not collect documents at this stage until after shortlisting.

(V) SUBMISSION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS (CATEGORY A)

Prospective bidders are to submit bid for each of the Lot desired, three (3) hard copies each (one original & two copies) of the requested documents and Financial quotations to be submitted in separate envelopes (within the sealed financial envelope, electronic copies of the financial bids are to be submitted in a flash drive). Thereafter, put the two in one sealed envelope addressed to:

Interested Firms in Category B: are to submit the Expression of Interest (EOI) for each of the Lot desired, in three (3) hard copies each (one original & two copies). The EOI should be addressed as indicated above and submitted **not later than 12:00 noon on Monday, 24 May, 2021**.

(VI) OPENING OF EOI AND TECHNICAL BIDS

The EOI and technical bids will be opened immediately after the deadlines for submission at 12:00 noon on Monday, 24 May, 2021 and 12:00 noon on Monday, 21 June, 2021 respectively, at the NTBLCP conference room at the above stated address, while financial bids will be kept un-opened. Please, ensure that you sign the Bid Submission Register at the NTBLCP reception, NTBLCP will not be held liable for misplaced or wrongly submitted bids. (VII) GENERAL INFORMATION

- (i) Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorised by the bidder;
- (ii) Bids submitted after the deadline for submission would be returned unopened;
- (iii) All costs will be borne by the bidder;
- (iv) The detailed specifications of the supplies and Terms of Reference for services are assessable in the web site of NTBLCP (ntbicp.org.ng).
- (v) Only price quotations of vendors with complete documentation will be considered.
- (vi) Presence of bidders/representatives and members of the public shall not be required during the bid opening ceremony in compliance with COVID-19 Guidelines. The Bids Opening will be covered by video recording with the presence of two (2) representatives of private sector professional bodies and Civil Society Organisation in the areas of Anti-Corruption/Transparency and shall be made available to bidders upon request;
- (vii) Bid documents can also be collected in soft copies and Bidders can submit through Post (Courier Services);

- (viii) Category A: Only pre-qualified bidders at technical evaluation will be invited at a later date for financial bids opening, while the financial bids of unsuccessful bidders will be returned un-opened
- (ix) Category B: Only shortlisted firms will be invited at a later date for collection of Request for Proposals (RfPs);
- (x) The NTBLCP is not bound to contract any bidder and reserves the right to annul the Procurement process at any time without Incurring any liabilities in accordance with Section 28 of the Public Procurement Act 2007.
