## (3.0) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- (e) Evidence of Current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2018.
- (f) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring January, 2019 or valid Certificate issued by BPP;
- (g) Company's Audited Account for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016, 2017);
- (h) Evidence of Financial Capability to execute the Projects/Programmes including Reference Letters from a reputable Commercial Bank indicating willingness to provide Credit Facility for the Execution of the Projects/Programmes when needed. Letters of Introduction from Banks without Commitment is not acceptable. Evidence of duly stamped/sealed Statement of Accounts evidencing adequate funds/cash flow will also be accepted;
- (i) Comprehensive Company Profile indicating Organization Structure with the Curriculum Vitae for key staff to be deployed for the project, including Copies of their Academic/Professional Qualifications such as COREN/QSRBN/ARCON/NSE e.t.c;
- (j) Letter of Authorization from the Original Equipment Manufacturers in accordance with approved policy for procurement of Health and Medical Equipment for Tertiary Hospital in Nigeria, for Bidders of Medical Equipment.
- (k) Resumes of key Managerial and Technical Staff (with Professional Certifications) with addresses, phone numbers and e-mail Addresses.
- (I) Evidence of Firms Registration with Relevant Professional Bodies. COREN/QSRBN/ARCON/NSE etc. (where applicable):
- (m) Verifiable evidence of at least Three (3) similar Jobs of interest in the last Five (5) years with attached copies of letters of award and Certificate of Completion and/or Valuation Certificates and Photographs of the Project (including Project Notice Boards).
- (n) List of Plants/Equipment with Proof of Ownership/Lease (where applicable).
- (o) For Joint Ventures/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (all the eligibility requirements are compulsory for each JV partner).
- (p) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a duly signed covering/forwarding letter under the Company/Firms Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), the Contact Address, Telephone Numbers (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper MUST bear the names and nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page duly signed by the Authorized Officer of the Firm;

- (q) A current Sworn Affidavit that:
- (i) The Company is not bankrupt, in receivership or under liquidation or involved in any litigation which can potentially affect the company's ability to effectively discharge their responsibility if engaged;
- (ii) The Claims made and information provided by the company in submission are true and correct in all ramifications;
- (iii) No member of staff of Federal Teaching Hospital, Abakaliki, (FETHA) Ebonyi State and Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) has pecuniary interest in the Company;
- (iv) No Director of the Company (past or present) has ever been convicted of criminal offences relating to fraud or financial impropriety in any court of law.
