(1.0) INTRODUCTION

The National Obstetrics Fistula Centre, Ningi is a North East Regional Centre established by the Federal Government of Nigeria for the prevention, treatment and rehabilitation of patients with Obstetrics Fistula and similar disorders. Its mandate also includes Research and Training.

(2.0) SCOPE OF WORK FOR THE PROJECTS

(3.0) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Prospective Bidders must possess the under-listed requirements to be eligible to participate in this procurement

- (g) Company's Audited account for the last three years (2016, 2017 & 2018);

- (h) Current sworn affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of relevant committees of the National Obstetrics Fistula Centre, Ningi or Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, Shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and confirm all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;
- (i) Only companies included in the National Automotive Design and Development Council's approved list of local manufacturers of vehicles or their authorized representatives should bid for this lot;
- (j) List and verifiable documentary evidences of at least three (3) similar jobs successfully executed within the last five (5) years including letters of awards/job completion certificates.
- (k) Company profile with Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their academic and professional certificates.
