- (h) Company's Audited Account for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016 & 2017);
- (i) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- (j) Company Profile with curriculum of key staff to be deployed for the project including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications;

- (k) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job completion certificates and Photographs of the projects;
- (I) List of plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease
- (m) For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided;
