(1.0) INTRODUCTION

The Hospital is to be managed under the Public Private Partnership to ensure effective and sustainable delivery of health services. To ensure this, the state government has approved the provision of additional hospital equipment of various types to complement the already existing equipment

- (ii) Certificate of incorporation with Cooperate Affairs Commission (CAC)
- (iii) Evidence of carrying our similar job done in the immediate past three years.
