- The Federal Government of Nigeria has received a Credit from the International Development Association (IDA) toward the cost of Lagos EKO Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to cover eligible payments under the contract for the Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Training **Equipment for Electrical Engineering**
- The Government Technical College, Ikotun now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Training Equipment for Electrical Engineering Workshop for the Government Technical College, Ikotun under the Project sub-component for Public-Private Partnership in Technical Education.

- Provision of annual audited account for the last 3 years to demonstrate:
- The current soundness of the applicant's financial position and its prospective long term profitability, and
