- c. Project Manager with B.Sc. Civil Engineering and at least 15 years experience in Works of equivalent nature and volume;
- d. Provide Annual audited account for the last 3 years; to demonstrate the current soundness of the applicant's financial position and its prospective long term profitability, and have Liquidity and/or evidence of access to or availability of confirmed positive credit facilities of not less than the amount in paragraph 3 above.

A margin of preference for eligible national contractors/joint ventures shall not be applied.
