Invitation to Pre – Qualify for Turnkey Transmission Projects

Background and Objective

Transmission Company of Nigeria (TCN) is a parastatal company that is the nation-wide licensee, owner and operator of the Nigerian transmission system, which consists of high voltage 330 kV and 132 kV lines, substations and control facilities. Across Nigeria, TCN is divided into eight transmission regions, which report to TCN headquarters in Abuja.

This request for qualifications seeks to identify a shortlist of contractors for contractorfinanced turnkey transmission projects. Applicants who prequalify will be eligible to enter into deferred payment asset sale contracts resulting from the bidding for which this pregualification is conducted.

Scope Of Works

The contract facilities will consist of rehabilitation, repair, replacement and expansion of 330kV & 132kV lines and 330/132kV & 132/33kV substations and transformers. The contract Facilities are located nationwide. The scope of works shall include all engineering, procurement and construction services, including supply and installation of new equipment, adaptation and repair of existing equipment, spares, tools and whatever may be necessary to have complete installations of the contract facilities.
