(e) Bidders shall have an average annual turnover of not less than Two Hundred and Eighty Million Naira (N280, 000,000.00) in the last three years.

(f) Pension Clearance Certificate valid for 2016 issued by the National Pension Commission (PENCOM).

(g) Industrial Training Fund (I.T.F.) Certificate valid for 2016 in compliance with Section 6 of the Industrial Training Fund Amendment Act, 2011.
