## (A) Background

Family Health International (FHI 360) with funding from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) through the Strengthening Integrated Delivery of HIV/AIDS Services (SIDHAS) project is supporting the government of Nigeria (GON) to enhance sustained cross-sectional integration of HIV/AIDS services by building Nigerian capacity to deliver sustainable high quality, comprehensive, prevention, treatment, care and related services in various states within Nigeria. - (5) Submit detailed Company Profile with registered address, functional email, and telephone number(s). The profile will also contain copies of company registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission, including form CAC7 & CAC2.
