

7. Copies of the Bids Evaluation Report by the Sub-technical Committee of the Tenders Board
8. Copies of minutes of the meeting of the Tenders Board approving the winning bidder.
9. Copies of bids rejection letters or notices, if any
10. Copies of letter of notification of award of contract
11. Signed contract document
12. Copy of the letters of the Federal Executive Council (FEC) for the approval of the contracts
13. Copy of formal appeal by bidders (Protest letter) and the decision in such appeals/complaints if any.
14. Copy of letter of request by the Tenders Board for certificate of "No Objection"
15. Copies of BPP Certificate of "No Objection"
16. Copies of summary of details of contracts published by your Agency or BPP
17. Documentation showing current status of project
