4. The amount utilized by your MDA for each of the listed projects within the 2014 fiscal year

This request is in line with Section 2(3) and (4) of the Freedom of Information Act, 2011, which require all "...information relating to the receipt of expenditure of public or other funds of the institution" to be "widely disseminated and made readily available..."

I would appreciate the receipt of documents with this information promptly and in any event, not later than 7 days of this application as required by the Freedom of information Act, 2011.
