3. Qualifications requirements include:
4. Evidence of previous supply (sale) of similar equipment for the past 5 years.
5. Audited financial statements for the last three years.
6. Evidence of registration with appropriate/relevant Government Agency.

A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically shall not be applied. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.

A complete set of Bidding Documents English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non refundable fee of N10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Naira only) or US\$80.00 (Eighty Dollars only).
