RE: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (FOI) REQUEST FOR RECORDS OF PAYMENTS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS RELEASED TO THE VETERINARY COUNCIL OF NIGERIA IN THE YEAR 2014.

This is our response to your letter of 30th January, 2015 on the above mentioned subject matter.

1. Appendix 1 is the 2014 capital Appropriation for Construction of Specialist Veterinary Hospital and Consultancy services thereof.
2. Appendix 2 is detailed 2014 Capital Budget releases.
3. 2014 Capital Projects Budget Utilization.
 - a. 10,414,954.25 paid to 4th Instinct Limited, Suite 63, Dansvilla Plaza, behind AP filling station, Apo. Gudu, District, Abuja, being part payment of 15% mobilization fee.

- b. N1,000,000.00 paid to Adumaks Homes Ltd, being payment for redesigning of the building plan of the Specialist Veterinary Hospital to meet requirement of Department of Development Control (DCC).
- c. N1,039,183.75 paid to DDC, Abuja Metropolitan Management Control (AMMC) being payment for building plan approval.
4. Kindly note that the construction of the Specialist Veterinary Hospital has a completion period of 18 months and Council proposed (two hundred million Naira (N200,000,000.00) for this project in 2014.
5. I commend your efforts in utilizing the FOI Act because where such is done with good intension, it has the capacity to add value to Capital Budget implementation for the general good.
6. Kindly revert to us for further explanation of possible grey areas as our doors are always wide opened.
