(1) CORRIGENDUM

 - (4) Evidence of Registration with Corporate Affairs Commission, namely Certificate of incorporation, memoranda and Articles of Association, forms CAC7, CAC2 and CAC/BN/A1 (certified true copies).

- (5) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs in the last five (5) years including Letters of Award, Valuation Certificates and Job Completion Certificates.
- (6) Duly Stamped Company Audited Accounts for years 2015 -2017.
- (7) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of reference letter from a reputable Commercial Bank indicating willingness to provide Credit Facility for the execution of the project when needed.
- (8) Evidence of current Pension Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2018.
- (9) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2018.
- (10) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 1/1/2019 or valid certificate issued by BPP.
- (11) Bank Statement for the past 12 months beginning from 1st March, 2017 to 30th April, 2018.
- (12) Reference Letter from two (2) previous clients on similar projects, satisfactorily completed to be included in the prequalification.
- (13) Evidence of sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the West African Examinations Council or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, Shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.
- (14) Sworn Affidavit that the company/firm is not in receivership/bankruptcy.
- (15) Sworn Affidavit that none of the directors or partners of the company/firm is an ex convict in any country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety.
- (16) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31stDecember, 2018.
