INTRODUCTION

OBJECTIVE OF THE RFP

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to enter into a contractual agreement with a successful bidder and select a suitable contractor to carry out the following work: Renovation of Gombe state office buildings.

Previous experience

Previous work with WHO, other international organizations and/or major institutions in the field of construction.

Logistical capacity

To have all the professionals with adequate experience required for the project.

Execute construction works according to the technical documentation provided (Bill of Quantities and architectural Drawings)

Supply all materials and required equipment to the site (Gombe)

Supply of equipment has to be supported by its installation, start -up and obligatory warranty

Perform works fully in accordance with relevant national standards and regulations.

Follow requirements, conditions, instructions and standards stipulated in technical

documentation.

Work to be performed

The successful bidder shall be readily available to deliver within timelines to be agreed upon.
