- And the distribution of these health products from the Zonal warehouses in Sokoto and Calabar zonal warehouses to 7,439 health facilities in 11 states (Sokoto, Katsina, Kano, Jigawa, Zamfara and Kebbi, Abia, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa, Cross River and Rivers).
