- Sanitary/ Civil Engineer with a University degree Sanitary/ Civil Engineering, Public Heath Engineering or related technical field.

2. Installation of Solar-Based Power Supply Systems in 40 LGA WashDepartments

Background

UNICEF is implementing WASH Projects in 40 LGAs across 19 States of Nigeria. In some of these project LGAs, there is complete absence of public power supply and to address, UNICEF has procured 40 Sets of Solar based Power Systems. To this effect, a competent and experienced Electrical Engineering Firm to install these systems in the 40 project LGAs is sought which is also expected to provide and install lightening protection and earthing for the systems.

Major Tasks

- Deliver the materials to location, install and test run
- Provide operation and maintenance guidelines and train LGA staff on the guidelines
