(1.0) INTRODUCTION

(2.0) SCOPE OF WORK

Contract is required to procure the services of well-trained medical professionals with cognate and relevant post qualification experience, including the services of Doctors, Nurses and other professionals.

Locum services will also be procured, which are required to fill staff slots that are vacant and to cover periods when Doctors, Nurses and other Health Staff ore absent, on training courses or on annual leave. These services are also required during periods when the demand for medical services increase (peak shaving periods), or when there is a need for a specialty service. The contractor personnel shall deliver cost-effective and curative general and specialist medical services to eligible Shell staff, dependants, contractors and third parties in line with Shell policy to sustain o healthy and productive workforce. The contractor personnel must be suitably qualified for the provision of the services, e.g. for Physician services, MBBS, BLS, ACLS and additional fellowship qualification(s) in the area of specialty plus a minimum of five (5) years' experience as a consultant in that specialty shall be required.

Note that a minimum of five (5) years post-specialization experience is required for ail services, except where deemed otherwise by Shell management.

(3.0) MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- Tenderers shall be Nigerian companies having amongst their Directors registered members of Nigerian Medical & Dental Practitioners
- Demonstrate that the bidding entity is a Nigerian registered company with greater than or equal to 51% Nigerian shareholding. Provide evidence of company Ownership Structure form C02 and C07, registration on NOGIC JQS and DPR certificate
- Provide evidence of registration with Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria (MDCN), and or provide evidence of permit/licence with Ministry of health (MOH) or recognized health management organization in Nigeria
- Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Administrative offices) in Nigeria to support this contract
- In line with the NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative, Bidder shall commit to providing Project- Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution (s).
- Submit Tenderer's corporate organizational and project/contract specific organogram.
