### (1) INTRODUCTION

TOTAL Upstream Nigeria Limited (TUPNI) invites interested and reputable indigenous contractors with suitable equipment and relevant experience to apply to be considered for inclusion in the tenderers' list for the subject tender.

## (2) BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK SCOPE

The scope of service includes the provision of experienced and qualified personnel, equipment, materials and consumables for the engineering, fabrication and testing and delivery of subsea pipeline repair clamps (Diverless) and possible installation in Akpo Field (OML130) when required.

A total of four (4) clamps are planned to be designed, manufactured and delivered between Q4 2020 and Q2 2021 in readiness for installation if a leak should occur.

### CONTRACT scope of work shall include but not limited to the following:

- Engineering design of subsea pipeline repair clamps (Diverless).
- Manufacture, including inspection services of clamps during manufacturing to ensure they
  comply with requirements and delivery of these clamps.
- Installation aids which includes but not limited to coating removal tools, ROV packages, and OEM personnel in the future etc.

Mobilization and demobilization of equipment, tools and consumables

Contract Duration – Two (2) Years firm with option for one (1) year extension.

### (3) MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- (a) To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested suppliers are required to be prequalified in the 3.05.10 Subsea Construction Services and 4.05.03 Subsea Systems category of the NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS). All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in this category will receive an Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT).
- (b) To determine if you are pre-qualified and view the product/service category you are listed for; open <a href="http://vendors.nipex-ng.com">http://vendors.nipex-ng.com</a> and access NJQS with your log-in details, click on "Continue Joint Qualification Scheme tool", then on "Check my supplier status" and then click "Supplier product group".
- (c) If you are not listed in the product/service category but you have registered with the Department of Petroleum Resources (DPR) to do business in the Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry, contact the NipeX administration office at 8 Bayo Kuku Road, Ikoyi, Lagos with your DPR certificate as evidence for verification and necessary update.
- (d) To initiate the NJQS pre-qualification process, access <u>www.nipex-ng.com</u> to download the application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.
- (e) To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian content requirements in the NipeX system.

### (4) NIGERIAN CONTENT

TUPNI is committed to the development of the Nigerian Oil and gas business in compliance with the Nigerian Content Act 2010 for Nigerian Content Development.

As from the commencement of this Act, the minimum Nigerian Content in any project, service or product specification to be executed in the Nigerian oil and gas industry shall be consistent with the level set in the Schedule of the Act and any other targets as may be directed by the Nigerian Content Development and

Monitoring Board (The Board)

Tenderer(s) shall comply with all the provisions of the Nigerian Content Act that relate to this advert and in particular comply with the minimum Nigerian Content percentage for the scopes which are covered in the Schedule of the Act. This also includes any other requirement that may arise from time to time not explicitly stated in this advert but which applies to the services in fulfillment of the Nigerian Content Act, in the submission of their Tender.

Failure to fully comply with the Nigerian Content Act or demonstrate commitment to Nigerian Content Development Policy of the Nigerian government shall result in the disqualification of the tenderer from the bidding process.

### As part of their submissions, Tenderer shall:

- (a) Provide evidence of company Ownership Structure form C02 and C07, registration on NOGIC JQS and DPR certificate.
- (b) Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Technical/Administrative offices) in Nigeria to support this contract.
- (c) In line with the NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative, Bidder shall commit to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- (d) Submit bidder's corporate organizational and project/contract specific organogram. CV's of all personnel listed in the project organogram should be submitted. For any position to be occupied by expatriate, tenderer shall provide evidence to obtain expatriate quota approval granted by NCDMB before any expatriate is deployed to execute this work scope".
- (e) All OEM equipment for the clamps and associated services shall be procured through a local vendor.
- (f) Provide evidence of relationship between the local vendor (with evidence of category A NCEC) and the OEM.
- (g) Provide evidence of at least 50% Nigerian ownership of temporary equipment, tools and consumables.
- (h) The deployment of Nigerian Owned ROVs and accessories by providing evidence of Nigerian ownership of the ROVs, or MOA with the Nigerian owner of the nominated ROV.
- (i) Provide Category C NIGERIAN CONTENT EQUIPMENT CERTIFICATE (NCEC) issued by Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board in respect of Nigerian ownership of mentioned equipment.

**NOTE:** Failure to comply with the provision of the Nigerian Content Act 2010 or to demonstrate commitment to the development of the Nigerian Content Policy shall result in the disqualification of the tenderer from the bidding process.

### (5) CLOSING DATE

Only tenderers who are registered with NJQS Product/Category: 3.05.10 Subset Construction Services and 4.05.03 Subsea Systems category with a "LIVE" subscription status at **4:00pm on 30 October, 2020** being the advert close date, shall be invited to submit Technical Questionnaire and Technics Bids and.

### (6) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- (a) Failure to provide any of the listed documents or information may automatically disqualify the tenderer.
- (b) All costs incurred in registering and prequalifying for this and other service categories in NJQS shall be borne solely by the Contractors/suppliers.
- (c) This advertisement shall neither be construed as an invitation to Tender (ITT) nor a commitment on the part of TUPNI to award a contract to any supplier and/or associated companies, subcontractors or agents.
- (d) The ITT and any further progression of this tender shall be via NipeX. Interested bidders are therefore advised to ensure that their profiles in NipeX are active with a valid official email address accessible by their organization as this shall be the only means to transmit the ITT.
- (e) Tendering process will be the NNPC contracting process requiring pre-qualified companies to submit both technical and commercial tenders together. Following a technical review, only technical and financially qualified tenders will have their commercial bids opened.
- (f) Man hour figures for Capital Project Portfolios are estimates to provide definition to the scope and do not constitute guaranteed quantities.
