TENDER OPPORTUNITY FOR: PROVISION OF ACCESS CONTROL IN OFFICES AND CIVIL GUARDS IN RESIDENCES SERVICES FOR DEEP WATER TOTAL UPSTREAM

(1) Introduction

Total Upstream Nigeria Limited (TUPNI) operator of the OML 130 Invites interested and reputable indigenous suppliers with suitable equipment and relevant experience for consideration to tender for the provision of access control in offices and civil guards in residences for Deep Water.

(2) Brief description of Work Scope and Specifications

Scope of SERVICES include the provision of Access Control in Offices and Civil Guards in Residences Services within OML 130 PERMIT for a duration of two (2) firm years plus one (1) option of yearly extension (2yrs+ 1yr) COMPANY'S sole discretion.

- The operation and management of guard services in order to prevent unauthorised access, protect life, maintain order, deter criminal attacks against the property and terrorist acts against all COMPANY assets, and prevent damage to COMPANY property.
- The Service is to be performed at COMPANY'S offices/residences in Lagos.

This requirement is to be fulfilled on a permanent basis for the whole duration of the CONTRACT by trained guard personnel for posts designated and for the hours scheduled by their supervisor.

- The "On Call" basis is subject to specific request by COMPANY, of trained Security guard, escort service or Bodyguard, for short term temporary requirement within Nigeria. The duties and the exact location will be specifically stated by the COMPANY when such SERVICES are directed. Subject to a formal written request by the COMPANY and acceptance by the CONTRACTOR, these SERVICES will be initiated by an Order activating, upon acknowledgement by the CONTRACTOR, the present CONTRACT. If an official start up report is established, it will be signed consecutively by the representatives of the PARTIES,

- Compliance with Voluntary Principle on Security & Human Rights (VPSHR) by CONTRACTORS workforce
- Implementation of the COMPANY security management policy.

(3) Mandatory Requirements

(a) To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested suppliers are required to be pre-qualified and have a “LIVE” subscription status in the following NJQS service/product group categories:

(1) Security Services (Product Code 3.18.05) by the CFT advert closing date. All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in any of these categories will receive an invitation to submit their Tender for the services.

(b) To determine if you are pre-qualified and view the product/services category you are listed for: Open <http://vendors.nipexjqs.com> and access NJQS with your log in details. Click on Products/Services Status tab to view your status and product codes.

(c) If you are not listed in the product/service categories mentioned above but you have registered with the Department of Petroleum Resources (DPR) to do business in the Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry in those areas, please contact the NipeX administration office at 8/10 Bayo Kuku Street, Ikoyi Lagos with your DPR certificate as evidence for verification and necessary update.

(d) To initiate the NJQS pre-qualification process, access www.nipex-ng.com click on “Service” tab followed by “NJQS Registration”

(e) To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian content requirements in the NipeX system.

(f) Only Nigerian indigenous service companies having verifiable Nigerian equity shareholding of 51% and above shall submit bids for this tender;

(4) Nigerian Content Requirements

TUPNI is committed to the development of the Nigerian Oil and gas business in compliance with the Nigerian Content Act 2010 for Nigerian Content Development.

As from the commencement of this Act, the minimum Nigerian Content in any project, service or product specification to be executed in the Nigerian oil and gas industry shall be consistent with the level set in the Schedule of the Act and any other targets as may be directed by the Nigerian Content Development and Monitoring Board (The Board)

Tenderer(s) shall comply with all the provisions of the Nigerian Content Act that relate to this advert and in particular comply with the minimum Nigerian Content percentage for the scopes which are covered in the Schedule of the Act. This also includes and any other requirement that may arise from time to time not explicitly stated in this advert but which apply to the services in fulfillment of the Nigerian Content Act, in the submission of their Tender.

Failure to fully comply with the Nigerian Content Act or demonstrate commitment to Nigerian Content: Development Policy of the Nigerian government shall result in the disqualification of the tenderer from the bidding process.

As part of their technical tender submissions, Tenderer shall;

(a) Submit a plan for how you intend to give first consideration to services provided from within Nigeria with a list of work packages, 3rd party services and subcontracts that should be reserved for Nigerian indigenous contractors and those for Community Contractors including the list of services that will be provided by companies of Nigerian origin.

(b) Only Nigerian registered company with greater than or equal to 50% Nigerian shareholding shall bid for this work scope. Submit a certified copy of CAC forms 02 & 07 and or evidence of entity's Incorporation, shareholding and ownership structure in Nigeria.

(c) Provide detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (technical / maintenance office, and administrative space) in Nigeria to support this contract.

(d) In line with the NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative, Bidder shall commit to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).

(e) Provide evidence (personnel list and positions with organization chart to substantiate) of percentage of management that are Nigerian Nationals and the percentage of the total workforce that are Nigerians.

(f) Submit tenderer's corporate organization's overall human resources structure (mgt, supervisors, senior & junior skilled officers, etc) identifying positions manned/occupied.

(g) Tenderer shall be expected to submit verifiable evidence of the OEM's Nigerian Content Equipment Certificate (NCEC) issued by NCDMB during the technical phase of bidding.

(h) All bidders during tendering shall demonstrate how the NC targets of the NOGICD Act would be achieved in accordance with the services.

NOTE: Failure to comply with the provision of the Nigerian Content Act 2010 or to demonstrate commitment to the development of the Nigerian Content Policy shall result in the disqualification of the tenderer from the bidding process.

(5) Closing Date

Only suppliers, who are pre-qualified and have a “LIVE” status on NJQS category Security Services (3.18.05) as at **Monday 16 March 2020**, being the tender advert closing date, shall be invited to submit technical and commercial tenders.

(6) Additional Information

(a) Failure to provide any of the listed documents or information may automatically disqualify the tenderer.

(b) All costs incurred in registering and prequalifying for this and other service categories in N3QS shall be borne solely by the suppliers.

(c) This advertisement shall neither be construed as any form of commitment on the part of TUPNI to award any contract to any company and/or associated companies, subcontractors or agents, nor shall it entitle pre-qualified companies to make any claims whatsoever, and/or seek any indemnity from TUPNI and/or any of its partners by virtue of such companies having been pre-qualified in NJQS,

(d) The ITT and any further progression of this tender shall be via NipeX portal.

Interested suppliers are therefore advised to ensure that their profiles in NipeX are active with a valid official email address accessible by their organization as this shall be the only means to transmit the ITT

(e) Man hour figures for Capital Project Portfolios are estimates to provide definition to the scope and do not constitute guaranteed quantities.
