(3) If you are not listed in a product/service category you are registered with DPR to do business, contact NipeX office at 8, Bayo Kuku Road, Ikoyi, Lagos with your DPR certificate as evidence for necessary update.

(4) To initiate the NJQS prequalification process, access <u>www.nipex-ng.com</u> to download the application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.

(5) To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content Requirements in the NipeX system.

## (4.0) NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

Vendors are to demonstrate strict compliance with the provisions of Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development Act and also provide the following requirements:

Tenderer shall provide evidence of registration on the NCDMB NOGIC JQS.

(ii) Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Administrative/Technical Offices) in Nigeria to support this contract.

(iii) In line with the NCD Human Capacity Development Initiative, Tenderer shall commit to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).

(iv) Submit Tenderer's corporate organizational and project/contract specific organogram. CV's of all personnel listed in the protect organogram should be submitted. For any position to be occupied by expatriate, tenderer shall provide evidence to obtain expatriate quota approval granted by NCDMB before any expatriate is deployed to execute this work scope". Complete the -Personne1 manning below.

(v) Provide evidence of at least 50% Nigerian ownership of Equipment as stated in the scope of work.

(vi) Tenderer shall provide evidence of Nigerian Communications Commission's (NCC) permit/license.

(vii) Tenderer shall provide evidence of registration with Nigerian Communications Commission (NCC).

(viii) Tenderer shall provide evidence of Binding MOA with OEM SES for the execution of the work scope.

(ix) Tenderer shall provide details of in-country procurement plan and Binding MOA to source goods and materials.
