(1.0)INTRODUCTION AND PROJECT OUTLINE

## (4.0) NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

Vendors are to demonstrate strict compliance with the provisions of Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development Act and also provide the following requirements:

- (c) Furnish details of company ownership and shareholding structure. Also, submit clear photocopies of your CAC Forms C02 and C07

- (d) Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- (e) Provide a Nigerian Content Plan providing a detailed description of the role, work scope, man-hours and responsibilities of all Nigerian companies and personnel that would be involved in executing the work. Also, provide details of Nigerian Content focal point or manager.
- (f) State proposed total scope of work to be conducted by Nigerian personnel (whether contracted directly or under subcontract agreements) with names and addresses including evidences of well-equipped offices and workshop; attach past experience of such patronage.
- (g) Specific to this work, provide detailed plan for staff training and development on equipment repairs & maintenance and procurement (including all software to be used, number of personnel, name of organization providing such training and evidence of past training record) for Nigerian personnel including description of any specific programs in place for transfer of technology and skills to indigenous businesses and Nigerians over the next five (5) years.
- (h) Location of in-country facilities (Storage, workshops, repair & maintenance facilities and testing facilities)
- (i) Contractor must be willing and able to provide evidence of maximization of made in Nigeria goods and services.
- (j) Provide details on any other Nigerian Content initiative your company is involved in.
