(1.0) INTRODUCTION

THE SHELL PETROLEUM DEVELOPMENT COMPANY OF NIGERIA LIMITED hereby invites reputable and competent Nigerian Companies with the requisite expertise, experience, skilled manpower and technology to apply to be considered for inclusion in the bid list for the above tender.

(2.0) SCOPE OF WORK

CONTRACTOR shall design, prepare, direct, supervise, and execute Wellbore clean up, Casing clean out, offline and online well fluid filtration, Packet fluid provision and associated operations as defined herein, and assume liabilities as provided in the Contract, Consequently, CONTRACTOR shall provide:

- Wellbore clean up chemical cocktail
- Casing scrapper, casing brushes and related clean up tools
- Filtered Brine for Completions operations
- Fluid management tanks

These activities shall be rig and rig less based and would be executed on land, swamp and shallow offshore.

(3.0) MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- To initiate the NJQS prequalification process, access nipexng.com to download the application form, make necessary payments and contact the NipeX office for further action.
- To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.

(4.0) NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

Tenderers are to note that they will be requested during the technical tender to give full details of their relevant strategy to ensure that they fully comply with the Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development (NOGICD) Act, 2010 as non-compliance will constitute a FATAL FLAW in all tender evaluations. In line with the above, Tenderers will be required to ensure that information on the following, among others, is included in their technical submission:

- Tenderer, shall demonstrate that entity is a Nigerian-registered company with 51% or more shareholding capacity. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.). Tenderer shall provide evidence of registration with the NCDMB NOGIC JQS and DPR.
- Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- Provide a Nigerian Content Execution Plan providing a detailed description of the role, work scope, man-hours and responsibilities of all Nigerian companies and personnel that would be involved in executing the work. Also provide details of Nigerian Content focal point or manager.
- State proposed total scope of work to be conducted by Nigerian personnel (whether contracted directly or under subcontract agreements) with names and addresses including evidence of well-equipped offices and workshop; attach post experience of such patronage.
- Provide evidence of at least 50% Nigerian ownership of all equipment to be utilized in the execution of the work scope. Tenderers shall provide evidence of 1,2,3 or 4 Construction and moveable Equipment group (EC) NCEC and or Category A NCEC demonstrating ownership of Chemical blending plant or Category C NCEC to demonstrate at least 50% ownership of the filtration and wellbore cleaning equipment to be utilized in executing the work scope.;
- Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (Technical/Administrative office, workshop, chemical blend Plant, warehouse etc.) in Nigeria to support this contract.

- Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training Institution(s).
