Overview

ACCREDITATION OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOS) TO WITNESS THE IMPLEMENTATION OF RESETTLEMENT ACTION PLAN

The Federal Government of Nigeria, through the Transmission Company of Nigeria (TCN) has obtained a loan from African Development Bank (AfDB) for the proposed Nigeria Transmission Expansion Programme Phase 1 (NTEP-1).

TCN is in the process of reconstruction of Alaoji-Onitsha (Abia-Anambra State) 330kV single circuit to double circuit quad conductor transmission line (138km), for which all Projects -Affected Persons (PAPs) are to be resettled and/or compensated. TCN has granted PGM-CitiPowerJV the responsibility to implement the Resettlement Action Plan (RAP).

Qualified NGOs which must be non-profit are hereby invited for accreditation to witness the implementation of the RAP.

Interested NGOs should meet the following minimum criteria:

- (1) Be conversant with international standards in implementation of RAPs
- (2) Demonstrate sound knowledge of community development principles that can apply in this case
- (3) Possess excellent capacity to mobilize the personnel required for this assignment
- (4) Demonstrate understanding of the tasks involved
- (5) Possess capacity to supervise a large number of personnel.
- (6) Be properly documented and registered with CAC.
- (7) Must have verifiable physical presence in any of the three project affected states.
- (8) Must show evidence of handling similar assignments in any of three project affected states.
