(1) Introduction

Total Upstream Nigeria Limited (TUPNI) on behalf of Total Upstream Companies in Nigeria (TUCNI) invites interested and reputable indigenous suppliers with suitable equipment and relevant experience to apply to be considered for inclusion in the tenderers' list for the subject tender.

(2) Brief description of Work Scope and Specifications

- Successful suppliers shall provide necessary equipment, software, experienced and qualified
 personnel services, logistics and facilities in Nigeria required for the provision of seismic time
 and depth processing, reprocessing and inversion services as may be requested by TUPNI for
 marine streamer (2D & 3D) data, ocean Bottom seismic (OBN & OBC) data, 4D and Broad
 Band date.etc.
- Three (3) contracts will be awarded to three (3) different suppliers on a ratio of 40:30:30, with the 40% awarded to the technically qualified lowest bidder for the provision of;
- Processing and imaging of 2D and 3D Marine Streamer and OBS datasets.
- 4D processing of base and monitor datasets over producing fields for reservoir monitoring purposes.
- Brood Bond date processing Seismic Inversion processing for reservoir studies; Integration of Geophysical and Geological information.

(3) Mandatory Requirements

To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested suppliers are required to be pre-qualified in the 3.10,02 – 2D/3D/4D Seismic Data Processing Services and/or 3,10.08 – OBC Seismic Processing Services categories of the NipeX Joint Qualification Scheme (NJQS) data base. All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in this category will receive an invitation to submit a Technical Tender for the above Services.

To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the requirements of the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act, 2010. Non compliance shall result in disqualification from tendering for this opportunity.

(4) Nigerian Content

Tenderers should note that they will be requested to give full details of their relevant strategy to ensure that they fully comply with the Nigerian Oil & Gas industry Content Development (NOGICD) Act, 2010 during the technical tender stage as non-compliance will constitute a fatal flaw in all tender evaluations.

- In line with the above, tenderers will be required to ensure that information on the following, among others, is included in their technical submission:
- Demonstration that their entity is a Nigerian registered company by submitting certified true copies of CAC forms 10,02 a 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3. 2.4, 2.5, etc) including company memorandum & article of association and other evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & womership structure in Nigeria.
- Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (assets, equipment, technical office, administrative space, storage, workshop, assembly area, repair & maintenance, testing, laboratory, ate) in Nigeria to support this contract
- Demonstration that all data processing and geophysical interpretation shall be completely domiciled in Nigeria and performed from processing centers located in Nigeria.
- Demonstration and evidence to show Tenderer's Nigerian Content Equipment Certifications (NCEC) and registration as a service company for the applicable product category on the NOGIC JOS Portal of NCDMB
- Evidence (list of personnel and positions with organisational chart to substantiate) of percentage of key management positions held by Nigerians and the percentage of Nigerians in the total workforce.
- Tenderer's corporate organization's overall human resources structure (management, supervisors, senior & junior skilled officers, etc) identifying positions manned/occupied by Nigerian nationals with evidence of type of employment in-country and identifying the positions manned/occupied by other nationalities.
- Percentages of the skilled manpower and labour including key personnel that will be positions
 for Nigerian nationals and the percentage that will be positions for other nationalities for this
 contract in order to maximize the utilization of Nigerian resources on the contract in line with
 government policies.

- Positions that would be occupied by Nigerians and the positions to be occupied by other nationalities (include as a table the list of all skilled positions & key personnel and identify their manning nationality).
- Project specific Human capacity Development (HCD) training plan for Nigerian nationals to be selected from a national database on the NOGIC JQS, man-hour budget, skill development and technology transfer plan for Nigerian personnel. HCD training for this tender shall be 10% of project man-hours or 3% of each call off order value whichever is greater. Trainees shall be selected using the NCDMB empirical formula in the HCD procedure to estimate number of trainees. Tenderer shall also as part of the Nigerian content developed on the project submit an execution plan outlining all the applicable labour driven targets of the schedule of the NOGIC ACT
- R&D shall be carried out on the contracts under the auspices of NCDMB approved R&D cluster. Tenderer shall submit their R&D plan detailing: Scope (list areas of research, linkage to industry, key drivers and expected outcome), name of research cluster and Nigerian location of centers, R&D duration, R&D expenditure targets as percentage of the call off order value, and Goals (purpose, NC targets, milestones and deliverables performance reporting and period).

(5) Closing Date

Only suppliers, who are registered and have a "Live" subscription status in NJQS service category 2D/3D/4D Seismic Data Processing Services (3,10.02) and/or OBC Seismic Processing Services (3.10.00) categories at 4:00pm on Thursday 18th February 2016, being the advert closing date, shall be invited to submit technical tenders.
