#### 1. Introduction

Bidders are invited to express complete understanding, willingness and commitment to develop in-country capability and capacity for related items in compliance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act (NOGICD Act, 2010).

Pursuant to the above, bidders' submissions shall be evaluated strictly with the minimum evaluation criteria defined in the NOGICD Act provisions and Schedule. Only bidders whose submissions are in compliance shall proceed to the next stage of the tendering process

The following are some information/documentation that will be required for submission at the ITT stage:

1. Demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian Registered Company, or Nigerian Registered Company as the contracting entity in genuine alliance or joint venture with foreign company with details on scope and responsibilities of parties for this work. Such companies must show evidence of joint venture binding agreement duly, signed by the CEO of both companies including evidence or plans of physical operational presence and set-up in Nigeria

- Nigerian Content Plan with detailed description of the scope, man-hours and responsibilities of all Nigerian companies and personnel that are involved in executing the service;
- Details of Company ownership and shareholding structure with certified true copies
  of CAC forms CO2 and CO7, including, company memorandum & article of
  association and other evidence of entity's incorporation;
- 4. Supplier's sourcing strategy/plan for this scope of service, and evidence of source of products, materials etc.;
- 5. Current and in-place organization structure with detailed experience and skills of key management personnel with names;
- 6. Evidence (personnel list and positions with organization chary to substantiate) of percentage of management that nationals and the percentage of the total workforce that Nigerians;
- 7. Detailed training plan for the service;
- 8. Detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure (assets, equipment, storage Facilities etc) in Nigeria to support this contract or submit a credible and verifiable plan towards setting-up;
- 9. Details of the applicant's relationship with local suppliers and service providers (e.g. in the management of the logistic, personnel);
