(3) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

(a) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation Issued by the Corporate Affairs

Commission (CAC) including Form CAC 1.1 or CAC2 and CAC7;

- (b) Evidence of Company's Income Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2018, 2019, & 2020) valid till 31st December, 2021;
- (c) Evidence of Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 15 and above);
- (d) Evidence of Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 5 and above or the bidder's annual turnover is N50m and above);
- (e) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021;

- (f) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/12/2021 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.
- (g) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the University of Nigeria, Nsukka or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;
- (h) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years -2018, 2019 & 2020;
- (i) Reference Letter from a Reputable Commercial Bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- (j) Company's Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications such as COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON ETC.;
- (k) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;
- (I) Works: List of Plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease;
- (m) For Supply of Equipment Letter of Authorisation as representative of the Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs);
- (n) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/ Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

(4) SUBMISSION OF PRE-QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS

Prospective bidders are to submit bid for each of the Lots desired, one (1) hard copy of in MS Excel format, packaged in a sealed envelope and clearly marked as Technical Bid' addressed to The Vice-Chancellor, University of Nigeria, Nsukka and clearly marked with INVITATION TO PRE-QUALIFICATION FOR SOME NEEDS PHASE 4 PROJECTS AS THE CASE MAY BE (State clearly the Reference Number and Description of the Lot(s) desired).

Furthermore, the reverse of each sealed envelope should bear the name and address of the bidder and be dropped in the designated Tender Box in Room 226, Registrar's office, University of Nigeria, Nsukka Campus **not later than 12:00 noon on Monday, 10 January, 2022.**

(5) OPENING OF PRE-QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS

- (a) Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorised by the bidder

The Bids Opening will be covered by video recording (invitation link will be sent to bidders to join the bid opening online) with the physical presence of two (2) representatives of private sector professional bodies and Civil Society Organisation in the areas of Anti-Corruption/Transparency;
- (d) Bidders can submit through Post (Courier Services);

- (e) Only pre-qualified bidders after the technical evaluation will be invited at a later date for collection of Financial Bidding Documents.
