(v) Last three (3) years Audited Accounts of the firm duly signed and stamped by a certified Auditor to demonstrate the financial capability of the bidder in terms of profitability and adequate working capital. The required turnover for the project is N15,000,000.00 (Fifteen Million Naira) and above;

(vi) Original Bank Statement for the past twelve (12) months;

(vii) Current Certificate of Compliance with the provisions of the Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Amended Act 2011, issued by ITF;

(viii) Verifiable and documented evidence of successful completion of three (3) similar nature and magnitude contracts executed in the last five (5) years each giving scope, location, value and referral contact telephone number.

(ix) Evidence of financial capability of either cash at bank of N10,000,000.00 (Ten Million Naira) or letter of N10,000,000.00 (Ten Million Naira) overdraft facility availability, to be written by the Bank Manager of the Bidder/Tenderer;
