1. Certificate of Company's registration into the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC);
2. Current Tax Clearance Certificate for the immediate past three (3) years (2015, 2016 and 2017) with the Tax Identification Number (TIN);
3. Compliance with Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Amendment Act 2011 by inclusion of Compliance Certificate from ITF;
4. Compliance with Pension Reform Act, 2004 by inclusion of Current Clearance Certificate (2015, 2016, 2017) from National Pension Commission (PENCOM);
5. Clearance Certificate (2015, 2016, 2017) from National Pension Commission (PENCOM);
6. Evidence of registration on the Database of Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by inclusion of the Interim Registration Report (IRR) issued by Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) in line with the provision of section 5 (b) of the Public Procurement Act (PPA), 2007;
7. Current Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016, 2017), duly stamped by a Professional Accounting Firm/Audit Firm showing annual turnover;
8. Original Bank Statement for the past Twelve (12) Months and documents demonstrating availability of funds/liquid assets and /or credit facilities from the banker(s) to successfully complete the Contract;

9. Verifiable Evidence of similar Jobs successfully executed, or being executed within the last Five (5) years, indicating type, cost, location and evidence of award and completion;
10. List, Curriculum Vitae (Cvs), and copies of credentials of technical staff, indicating qualification, year(s) of cognate experience,
11. List of verifiable essential equipment, in full working condition to be used for the projects, listed as owned hired or leased;
12. Sworn Affidavit in line with provision of Part IV Section 16 Subsection 19(f) of the Procurement Act 2007:

- That all the documents submitted for the pre-qualification exercise are not only genuine, but fully correct;
- That the Director(s) of the prospective contractual company has/have never been convicted by any court of law;
- That neither the company nor any of the company director is bankrupt;
- That no officers of Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta (FUNAAB) is a former or present Director of the company;
- That the company is not in receivership.

**NOTE:-**

(1) The documents to be submitted should follow the order listed in a-k above. Each parcel should have a table of contents, indicating the pages on which these items are to be found.

(2) Interested contractors/suppliers should note that the original copies of the documents listed above would be requested and should be available for sighting, whenever required. Also, the bidding documents of any contract of/supplier that does not meet the above eligibility criteria, will not be considered. Electronic bidding win not be permitted, also late bids submission will be rejected.
