Expression of Interest (Outsourcing of Barcoding Technology for Health Survey) Background:

Family Health International (FHI 360) is a not-for-profit human development organization dedicated to improving lives in lasting ways by advancing integrated, locally driven solutions. Our staff includes expert in health, education, nutrition, environmental, economic development, civil society, gender equality, youth, research and technology – creating a unique mix of capabilities to address today's interrelated development challenges. With funding from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), FHI360's Nigeria Country Office is partnering with one of the state government to conduct AIDS indicator survey in the state.

The Country Office is hereby soliciting qualified and interested organizations to express their interest to deploy barcoding technology including hardware and software application. The barcode technology will be used to support sample management to improve survey workflow and reduce sample misidentification.

The survey will involve having barcodes produced with specific survey codes (Specific sites/household ID's) for deployment to the field teams; subsequently, corresponding barcodes which will be applied to label DBS/Plasma samples and other associated documents will be made available in testing laboratories for identification; inclusive will also be the software component of the barcode technology that should be able to synchronize the labelled barcodes in the testing laboratories and then generate a worksheet with the corresponding barcodes that would tally with the final results.

Qualified and interested organizations are required to submit their interest detailing their capacity to provide the barcoding technology for the survey.

Submission must:

(i) Demonstrate experience and/or ability to deploy barcode technology to support laboratory sample management in health related survey.

(ii) Demonstrate use of handheld barcode scanners and printers for associating clients/patients with collected samples.

(iii) Demonstrate ability to deploy and integrate Software technology to mobile Android devices,

(iv) Demonstrate ability to synchronize data to and from any database or software systems.

(v) Provide detailed company profile with registered address, functional email, telephone numbers and point of contact for the organization.

(vi) Provide recommendation letter from a reputable organization attesting to Satisfactory Performance in previous related job

(vii) Evidence of possession of experience in similar jobs;

Bidders must describe in sufficient details at least 3 projects similar in size, scope, and complexity (recently completed or in progress) carried out in the last five (5) years. The name, physical address, telephone number and contact e-mail address of the client must be provided.

(viii) Provide evidence of company registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission, including form CAC7 & CAC2.

(ix) Provide Tax Clearance Certificate for 2013, 2014, and 2015.

(x) Provide evidence of financial capability.

Note: Experience in providing barcode technology to support field surveys is a plus. Successful client must be ready to demonstrate the operationalization of this solution on demand consequent to being accepted.
