(1) INTRODUCTION

The hospital is desirous of engaging competent and reputable Company/Supplies with relevant experience, requisite, expertise and good track record and are invited to summit prequalification documents for the supply of hospital Drugs and Expression of Interest for Public Private Partnership.

(3) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each bidder must have the following as the minimum qualification that must be met to make him/her eligible. Thus, the interested companies/supplier should submit two (2)

documents duly signed, paginated, separated by divides and arranged in the order outlined here:

(a) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CAC1.1 or CAC2 and CAC7;

(b) Evidence of Company's Income Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years 2018, 2019 and 2020 valid till 31st December, 2021;

(c) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid 31st December, 2021;

(d) Evidence of current Pension Clearance Certificate Valid 31st December, 2021;

(e) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Clearance Certificate valid 31st December, 2021;

(f) Evidence with Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and service Providers by Submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31st December, 2021 or valid certificate Issued by BPP;

(g) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of Aminu Kano Teaching Hospital, Kano or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a farmer or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary Interest in the bidder and to confirm that all Information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;

(h) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years 2018, 2019 and 2020;

(i) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank indicating willingness to provide Credit facility for the execution of the supply when needed;

(j) Company's profile with Curriculum Vitae of key staffs to be deployed for the project, including copies of Academic/professional qualifications (Pharmacists Council of Nigeria);

(k) Verifiable documentary Evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed In the last five (5) years including letters of awards, and job completion certificate.

(I) For joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension Compliance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Compliance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV partner);

(m) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding Letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as Issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.) and e-mail address. The letter head Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

(n) Evidence of current premises licence/evidence of payment with the Pharmacist Council of Nigeria (PCN);

(o) Evidence of Current Practicing Licenses of the superintendent pharmacists with the Pharmacist Council of Nigeria;

(a) Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorised by the bidder;

(b) Bids submitted after the deadline for submission would be returned un-opened.

The Bids Opening will be covered by video recording with the presence of two (2) representatives of private sector professional bodies and Civil Society Organisation in the areas of Anti-Corruption/Transparency;
