- That the company is not bankrupt, in receivership or under liquidation or involved in any litigation which can
 potentially affect the company's ability to effectively discharge its responsibility if engaged;

 - (i) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
 - (j) Company Profile with toe Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications (in ease of construction; COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc.);
