ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

(b) Evidence of Company Incomes Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years valid till 31 December, 2019

(c) Evidence of current Pension Compliance Certificate valid till 31 December, 2019

(d) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31 December, 2019;

(e) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31 December,
2019;

(f) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31 January, 2020 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.

(g) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of HAFED POLY or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;

(h) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years – 2016, 2017, 2018;

(i) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria; indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;

(j) Company Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications;

(k) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the Projects.

(I)For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (Tax ClearanceCertificate,Pension Compliance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Compliance Certificate, IRR & SwornAffidavitarecompulsoryforeachJVpartner)(m)Alldocuments for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter HeadPaper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC),Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the

Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

(4.1) Prospective bidders are to submit pre-qualification documents for each of the Lot desired; two (2) hard copies each of the technical bids packaged in sealed envelope and clearly marked as "Technical Bid; and addressed to the Rector, Hussaini Adamu Federal Polytechnic, Kazaure, Jigawa State and clearly marked with toe name of the project and the Lot number;

(4.2) Furthermore, the reverse of each sealed envelope should have the name and address of the bidder and drop in the designated Tender Box at the Procurement Department not later than **1:30pm on Wednesday**, **16 October**, **2019**
