(3) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

SUPPLY TITLE/DESCRIPTION

- (a) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Forms CAC2 and CAC7;
- (b) Evidence of Company income's Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years valid till 31st December, 2019 with minimum average turnover of twenty million;
- (c) Evidence of current Pension Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2019;
- (d) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2019;
- (e) Evidence of Current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2019;
- (f) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/1/2020 or valid Certificate issued by BPP;
- (g) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Federal Government College, Malali, Kaduna or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;
- (h) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years 2016, 2017 and 2018;
- (i) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- (j) Company's Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Provisional qualifications (in case of construction: COREN QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc.);
- (k) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;
- (I) List of Plans/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease (where applicable);
- (m) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head paper bearing amongst others, the Registration number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorized officer of the firm.

(4) SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

Prospective bidders are to submit pre-qualification documents for each of the Lot desired; two (2) hard copies each of the technical bids if packaged in sealed envelopes and clearly marked as "Technical Bid"; and addressed to the Principal Federal Government College, Kaduna and clearly marked with (the name of the project and the Lot number). Furthermore, the reverse of each sealed envelope should have the name and address of the bidder and drop in the designated Tender Box located in the principal's office of Federal Government College, Malali, Kaduna not later than 12:00 noon on Monday, 18 November, 2019.

(5) OPENING OF PRE-QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS

The technical bids will be opened immediately after the deadline for submission at **12:00 noon on Monday**, **18 November**, **2019** in the Board room of Federal Government College, Malali, Kaduna in the presence of bidders or their representatives.
