#### (2) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

(a) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CAC2 and CAC7;

- (b) Evidence of Company Income's Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016 & 2017) valid till 31 December, 2018;
- (c) Evidence of current Pension Compliance Certificate valid till 31 December, 2018;
- (d) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31 December, 2018;
- (e) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31 December, 2018;
- (f) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 1/1/2019 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.

- (i) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project including Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- (j) Bidders for lots 1,4 and 6 should include their company Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications (COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc.).
- (k) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the protects
- (I) Evidence of current licenses for all the Medical personnel involved e.g. Doctors. Pharmacist. Nurses, Laboratory Scientist etc. must be attached (Lot 5).
- (m) List of Plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease (where applicable);
- (n) For Joint venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (all the eligibility requirements are compulsory for each JV partner)

- (o) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.
- (p) Letter of consent to allow for verification of all the documents submitted including CAC. Tax Clearance Certificate, Pencom, Industrial Training Fund (ITF), NSITF, BPP Interim Registration Report (IRR) and company's financial standing with the Banks.
