1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Federal University Wukari has received Approval-in-Principle (AIP)

from the Tertiary Education Trust Fund (TETFund) towards Library

development and wishes to apply the funds on the following projects under 2.1 and year 2017 Capital Appropriation Projects.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

Lot 1. Procurement of Library Furniture, Tools, and Equipment

Lot 2. Procurement of Assorted Textbooks. Journals in different disciplines and reference materials.

Lot 3. Procurement of Class room and office Furniture in ICT unit.

Lot 1. Supply of Equipment for the Hatchery in the Department of Animal Production and Health.

Lot 2. Supply of Equipment for the Poultry in the Department of Animal Production and Health

Lot 3. Supply of Hatchery Equipment for Fish Pond in the Faculty of Agriculture and Life Science.

- Evidence of incorporation and registration of company with Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) in compliance with section 16(6)(b) of the Public Procurement Act (PPA) 2007.
- Evidence of Company's current tax clearance certificate and audited account for the preceding three (3) years 2015,2016 and 2017 in line with section 16(6) (d) of the Public Procurement Act(PPA) 2007, duly signed and sealed by ICAN/ANAN licensed Auditors. (Note: The turnover in the audited account must match the turnover declared in the Tax Clearance Certificate).
- Evidence of current certificate of compliance with National Pension Commission (PENCOM) Amended Reform Act 2014;
- Current NSITF Clearance Certificate in compliance with Employees Compensation Act 2010 (ECA2010);
- Evidence of current compliance certificate with the Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Act No. 19 of 2011;
- Evidence of certificate of registration on the Bureau of Public Procurement National Data Base of Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by inclusion of Interim Registration Report (IRR);
- Verifiable Evidence of Financial Capability and reference letter from a reputable Bank;
- Verifiable evidence of the completion of similar projects in the past, name of the clients, location of the projects, contract sums and Letter of Engagement.
- Experience in executing similar works of the same magnitude.
- Every Submission must be accompanied with an affidavit that all information and documents submitted are true and correct and that no officer of the University is a former or present Director. Shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder.
- Evidence of Payment of tender fee of Ten Thousand Naira Only (N10,000.00) in bank draft, in favour of "Federal University Wukari" Tender Fee Collection Account 1000059270 and;
- Any other necessary information that may be required for the successful execution of the project.
